




Environmental Policy

NOMAC is committed to operate and maintain desalinization and power plants in a manner that prevents pollution and protects the environment where we operate. NOMAC's Management shall implement an Environmental Management System (EMS) that meets the requirements of the ISO 14001:2015 standard incorporating the following elements:

- Ensuring that all personnel will comply with applicable legal, environmental and lenders' requirements relating to the organization's environmental aspects;
- Ensuring that all personnel will be held accountable for maintaining a commitment to environmental stewardship and acting in accordance with this policy;
- Ensuring that environmental risks associated with operation and maintenance activities are managed in accordance with this policy at all NOMAC's sites;
- Taking reasonable and practical steps to avoid the unauthorized release of pollutants to the environment;
- Ensuring contractors and their employees are required to adhere to the same environmental performance standards as NOMAC personnel;
- Identifying the environmental impact of the organization's business activities and implementing proper measures to mitigate such impacts including reduction of natural resource consumption and minimizing emissions and waste;
- Ensuring NOMAC personnel are firmly committed to make environmental risk considerations an integral part of planning and operating decisions;
- Setting of EMS performance objectives and targets, conducting monitoring and implement actions to ensure attainment of the targets;
- Ensuring that fuels, chemicals, and other hazardous materials are received, stored, used and disposed in strict compliance with applicable standards in order to minimize environmental impact;
- Ensuring that all employees are competent and have the knowledge and skills necessary to conduct their work in a manner that complies with EMS requirements;
- Appropriately reporting of all environmental incidents, as per applicable regulations; and
- Ensuring that events are fully investigated and that corrective actions are duly taken to preclude recurrence.

Management will conduct periodic review of the EMS policy and ensure continual system upgrade and improvement and shall further communicate this policy to all interested parties.
